Day 01: Arrival in Tbilisi

Arrival at Tbilisi Airport and get transfer to your hotel. Overnight stay in hotel.

Day 02: Tbilisi City Tour

After breakfast starts Tbilisi city tour

Tbilisi city tour is a sightseeing tour of the highlights of Tbilisi. Explore the Old Town. The architecture in the city's





historic district is a mixture of Georgian, Byzantine, Oriental and Neo-Classical European styles. You will visit:

- ✓ Metekhi church
- ✓ Monument of Vakhtang Gorgasali, the legendary founder of Tbilisi
- ✓ Water fall
- ✓ Sulphur bath houses
- ✓ Visit Sioni Cathedral
- ✓ Rezo Gabriadze Theatre
- ✓ Peace bridge

Day 03: Day at leisure or Optional Kakheti - wine region and Sighnaghi Bodbe tour.

After breakfast, day at leisure or you can opt for the Kakheti – wine region tour at additional cost.

The one-day tour in Kakheti is a fascinating journey into the eastern part of Georgia, during which you can enjoy the mountain views, picturesque villages, ancient temples, and observe the life Kakhetians.

- ✓ Sighnaghi miniature city of love, which impresses with its history. It is the only city in Georgia that has fully preserved the fortress walls that are crowned with watchtowers, where one can climb to get the magnificent view of the Alazani valley.
- ✓ Visit Local Wine factory and taste different sort of wines.

Day 04: Departure

After breakfast, check out from hotel and get transfer to Tbilisi Airport.



TRAVEL GUIDELINES:

Entry rules for COVID-19 vaccinated visitors:

Citizens of all countries, traveling by air from any country may enter Georgia if they present the document confirming the full course (two doses) of any COVID-19 vaccination at the border checkpoints of Georgia.

* Except for any person coming from the Republic of India (regardless of citizenship and full course of vaccination) as well as persons who have a history of travel to the Republic of India during the last 14 days. They are subject to a negative result of the PCR test conducted in the last 72 hours before the visit to Georgia at the border and then - a mandatory 14-day quarantine (in the case of an alien, at his own expense).

Attention! Before crossing the Georgian state border, it is obligatory to complete the special application form, indicating the travel history of the last 14 days, contact details (address, phone number, email etc.) https://registration.gov.ge/pub/form/8 protocol for arrivals in georgia/tk6157/;

Entry rules for non-vaccinated visitors:

Citizens and residence permit holders of UAE and 20 more countries may enter Georgia by air under the conditions mentioned below:

For entering Georgia, they must comply with the following conditions:

- They must travel by air directly from the countries mentioned above, including transit travel through third countries; (Land and Sea borders remain closed);
- At the border checkpoint of Georgia they must present PCR-examination certificate conducted during 72 hours prior to travel to Georgia;
- On the 3rd day of their stay, they are obliged to undergo PCR-examination at their own expense;
- Before crossing the state border, they must complete the special application form, indicating
 the travel history of the last 14 days, contact details (address, phone number, email etc.)
 https://registration.gov.ge/pub/form/8 protocol for arrivals in georgia/tk6157/;
- All individuals who have travelled to the Republic of India within the last 14 days will be placed in mandatory quarantine for 14 days upon entry. In this case, PCR-examination on 3rd day of their stay will be waived.

NOTE:



- 1) https://registration.gov.ge/pub/form/8 protocol for arrivals in georgia/tk6157/. This form must be filled in before departure.
- 2) Mandatory follow up Covid- test within 72 h after arrival.

3) Current restrictions in Georgia:

- a) Curfew after 9 PM.
- b) Shopping malls open from 10:00 19:00
- c) Public transport is available from 8:00 to 20:00 all week.
- d) Indoor Restaurants open from 8th of march except weekends. Take away service is available for all restaurants every day.

Requirements for UAE resident visa holders: (If travelling by Fly Dubai)

- If you hold a valid Dubai-issued residence visa, make sure you can obtain an approval from <u>Dubai's General Directorate of Residency and Foreigners Affairs</u>
 (GDRFA) https://smart.gdrfad.gov.ae/Smart_OTCServicesPortal/ReturnPermitServiceForm.aspx
 to return to Dubai before booking your flight. Without approval to return to Dubai, you will not be accepted for travel.
- If you hold a valid residence visa issued by any other emirate, you will need to confirm your entry/re-entry to the UAE at <u>uaeentry.ica.gov.ae</u> before booking your flight. If you do not confirm your entry/re-entry to the UAE, you will not be accepted for travel.

- Please note that if you hold a UAE residence visa, you must not stay outside of the country for more than 180 days
- If you are required to take a COVID-19 PCR test on arrival in Dubai, you will need to quarantine until you receive your results. If you test positive for COVID-19, you must quarantine for 14 days. You will also need to download the COVID19 DXB Smart App (from Apple App Store or from Google Play Store) and register with the Dubai Health Authority prior to arrival in Dubai.
